

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## Asphalt Surface Restoration





- 1. Lay out and mark all areas of repair.
- Cut and heel around perimeter of area to be repaired with a 1" tailing depth at the butt end.
- Clean repair area of vegetation, dirt and surface debris as required. Dispose of all debris offsite.
- Mechanically apply liquid asphalt tack coat to complete area of surface repair.
- Install 2" average minimum depth of hot mix asphalt surface course material.
- Roll surface course to achieve a true and firm finish. Match existing grade at butt of heel.
- Apply a seal of liquid asphalt to the adjoining edges of the finish repair to help prevent moisture penetration.

NOTE: Asphalt General is not responsible for ponding water or poor drainage in areas where grade is less than 2%.

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
