

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Full-Depth Concrete Base and Finish Asphalt Restoration



- Lay out and mark all areas of repair.
- Excavate areas to be repaired to a depth of 8". Dispose of all debris offsite.
- Square surface of repair and cut walls of repair to produce vertical edges.
- Roll existing surface materials to achieve maximum density,
- Install 6" depth 3,500 PSI air entrained and reinforced concrete. Rough-broom finish concrete to 2 " below top of adjacent paving and cure to ensure bonding of the new asphalt surface.
- Tack new coat surface of base to produce proper bonding to new surface course.
- Install 2" of hot mix asphalt surface course material.
- Roll surface course to achieve a true and firm finish match existing grade.
- Apply a seal of liquid asphalt to the adjoining edges of the finished repair to help prevent moisture penetration.



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
